Remembrance Day Protocol

A. Background and Definitions

B. Purpose

The Niagara College community wants to ensure a thoughtful, timely and respectful observance of the National November Day of Remembrance for fallen Canadian soldiers. To this end, each year, on November 1 the following protocol shall apply:

C. Practice Statements

- 1. <u>The President's foce will:</u>
 - x attend or send a delegate to any official ceneres held on campus involving Canadian veterans or other dignitaries, as invited.
- 2. The Human Resourcespartment will:
 - x notify Campus Security re: lowering of flags to handast
- 3. <u>The Marketing and Communications department will:</u>
 - a) post a timely notice to staff;
 - b) involve media in any spediavents taking place on campus;
 - c) post a remembrance message from the President in the student newspaper, published closest to and preceding the day; and,
 - d) coordinate a campus wide message.
- 4. <u>The InformationTechnology Serviceseppartment will</u>:
 - x at 11:00 a.m., broadcast **all** gewide announcement that includes a reading of the poem In Flanders Field by John McCrae followed by a direction to listeners to observe a minute of silence.

^{*} in cases where NovemberthIfalls on a Saturday or Sunday, the preceding Friday shall be designated the day of observance.

PRACTICE TITLE: Remembrance Day Protocol (November)

- 5. <u>The Student Servicesepartment will:</u>
 - a) liaise with the Student Administrative Council to infoand/or assist regarding any special activities, ceremonies or ebsances taking place on campus; and,
 - b) the Director of Student Services Office will coordinate Ollege representatives to attendvarious regional events.

Other Items for Consideration

- 6. Calls/inquiries/visits by members of the media regarding the College's Remembrance Day observances are to be referred to the Marketing and Communications O
- 7. Requests by family/friends/staff to honour fallen veterans by way of a memorial bursary maybe referred to the Foundation & Alumni Relation fi@.
- 8. Waived or reduced parking and other user fees for veterans attending campus for special purposes related to Remembrance Day (guest speaking, ceremonies, etc.).
